Are you a foodie who loves to bake, or a professional chef interested in showing off your pastry-making prowess for a great cause?

If so, then Hilton Head Heroes has a “sweet” opportunity for you! On Saturday, March 13, 2010, Heroes will sponsor the 2nd Annual Pie Baking Contest to be held during the 25th Annual Hilton Head Island Wine & Food Festival. Judging will begin at noon.

If you would like to participate, please read the enclosed Rules & Regulations and submit the attached application by or before March 12!

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. **Eligibility.**
 - a. This contest is open to the public. Both professional and amateur chefs may enter.
2. **Categories.**
 - a. Fruity.
 - i. All pies submitted in this category must include at least one (1) cup of fruit in the recipe.
 - b. Rich & Creamy.
 - i. All pies submitted in this category must include at least one (1) cup of dairy in the recipe.
 - c. Diverse & Delicious.
 - i. No requirements. This is a great opportunity to be creative!
3. **Rules.**
 - a. Contestants may submit one (1) entry per category.
 - b. Contestants must submit at least two (2) identical pies per entry: one pie for judges to sample, one for public to purchase.
 - c. Contestants must submit the pie recipe. The recipe used may be contestant's own or simply a favorite(s). Include recipe source if not your own.
 - d. Contestants must submit pies in a non-returnable pan. No glass containers will be accepted, unless prior arrangements have been made with a Heroes representative. After judging has been completed, pies will be available for purchase.
 - e. All contestants must agree to have their name, pie recipe, and/or pie photographed and published.
4. **Submission Process.**
 - a. Contestants should bring pies to Honey Horn between 10:30 and 11:30 am the morning of Saturday, March 13, 2010. Pies will not be accepted after 11:30 a.m. A Heroes representative will meet you at the festival entrance.
 - b. Each entry submitted will be recorded and assigned a number.
 - c. During judging, the pie will be displayed only with the assigned number.

5. **Judging.** The judging will be conducted by local judges. All decisions are final. Judging will be based on the following:
 - a. Appearance 10%
 - b. Crust 10%
 - c. Creativity 10%
 - d. Filling 20%
 - e. Flavor/Taste 50%

6. **Awards & Prizes.** Winners will be announced at 2 pm at the Hilton Head Island Wine & Food Fest at Honey Horn.
 - i. Prizes: Gift certificate for tickets to an Arts Center of Coastal Carolina show. Other prizes TBA.
